Coaches Comments: The Omaha Brownell-Talbot Raiders defeated the Elmwood-Murdock Knights 23-13 Friday night in Omaha. The Raiders struck first in the 1st quarter on a 27 yard field goal by Joe Tunzer set up by a Knight turnover at midfield. The Knights responded quickly with a 70 yard touchdown run by Tyler Oehlerking. The Knights led at the end of the 1st quarter 6-3. Towards the end of the 2nd quarter the Raiders hit pay dirt with a 2 yard run by Harrison Runnels giving the Raiders a 9-6 halftime lead. I thought we played a good first half. We moved the ball well at times but need to be more consistent. We had a hard time stopping their counter sweep. The Raiders scored on their 1st possession of the 3rd quarter on a 7 yard pass from Ehresman to Rory McCarthy. The PAT gave the Raiders a 16-6 lead. The Knights had a good drive stall at the Brownell-Talbot 20 yard line late in the 3rd quarter. With 6 minutes left in the 4th quarter the Knights went to their No Huddle offense getting several 1st downs and eventually scoring on a 9 yard pass from Brandon Frates to Tyler Oehlerking. Lutz kicked the PAT and the Knights now trailed 16-13 with 4:27 left in the game. We felt there was enough time left for our defense to get the ball back so we decided against an onside kick. We kicked away from their best return man Krishn Rappoor but he went to the right corner of the field to get the ball. He ran across the field and then reversed his field to the right sideline. We actually covered the kick well forcing the return man to our sideline. Our contain man was in good position to make the tackle but Rappoor avoided the tackle and raced 77 yards for a TD. The Knights host Archbishop Bergan Friday night. Game time is 7:00 p.m.
